

Right now my C drive space is 20 gb and D drive space is 50 gb. How can I increase my C drive space? | C

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You could delete some files and folders on your C drive to make more room, but if you are saying that you want to take some memory from the D drive over to the C drive, that is not possible.

The drives are fixed sizes, and cannot be transferred to one another, unless of course D is just a partition of the C drive, in which case you can increase and decrease the size of both using a disk management utility but you might lose some data.

Also, you could make your D drive your C drive, and vice versa, but then you would have to transfer everything over from your C drive to your D drive at first, then change it to the C drive.
